

RICE MARKETING BOARD 2017 Election of Three (3) Board Members

Election Notice

The Electoral Commissioner for NSW as Returning Officer will conduct an election of three (3) producers' representatives to the Rice Marketing Board for the State of New South Wales. For this election the whole of the State of NSW is the electoral district.

Nominations

Nominations are invited on and from Thursday 7 September 2017 to elect Three (3) Board Members.

Eligibility for Nomination

Any person is eligible for nomination as a candidate. Candidates must give written consent to their nomination.

Qualifications for Nominating Candidates

Each candidate for election must be nominated by not less than six (6) persons (other than the candidate) each of whom have the prescribed qualifications.

Lodgement of Nominations and Candidate Information Sheet in Support of Candidature

Completed Nominations and Candidate Information Sheet in Support of Candidature must be received by the Returning Officer, NSW Electoral Commission by no later than **12.00 noon, Friday 29 September 2017**.

Nomination forms can only be lodged with the Returning Officer at the NSW Electoral Commission:

Any defect in a nomination must be rectified prior to the close of nominations at **12.00 noon**, **Friday 29 September 2017**. A nomination can only be withdrawn by a written, signed statement received by the Returning officer prior to the close of nominations.

Voting

Should the election be contested, a draw to determine the order of candidates' names on the ballot paper will be conducted at **2.00pm**, **Friday 20 October 2017** at the NSW Electoral Commission, Level 25, 201 Kent Street, Sydney. Candidates or their representatives are invited to witness the draw.

A postal ballot will be conducted to close at **12.00 noon**, **Monday 20 November 2017**. Voting material will be posted on **Wednesday**, **25 October 2017**. The method of voting to be observed will be First Past the Post.
